We will be also be running the introductory bookbinding sessions online meaning you can take part from the comfort of your home, whilst connecting on screen with fellow veterans. We will send you the materials and tools and everything you need to take part and a quality notebook will be the result! We are also pursuing funding to finance the cost of travel and accommodation to The Daffodil Barn workshop so that those of you who are part-way through your City & Guilds qualifications, and who used to rely on Tedworth House for accommodation and transport, can stay in a local B&B and complete your certificates.

For those who have never been to the barn, which is situated in a beautiful rural area of Wiltshire offering a breath of fresh air and space, the classes take place in a friendly small workshop with a maximum of 6 people. You have no obligation to do C&G qualifications but you are eligible for them if you complete the course – however, there is no pressure to achieve the certificates. Our aim is to offer a therapeutic activity which, as Stefan once said 'stops my mind going at a million miles an hour'.

As mentioned above, we are pleased to announce that BBV Introduction to Bookbinding sessions are being started again:

- At Tedworth House, Tidworth: These are two-hour in-person sessions running monthly from March to December 2022. Further details are given below.
- Veteran Outreach Support (VOS) Portsmouth: New, in-group two-hour sessions are to be held at Portsmouth. See below for further details.
- Online Individual Introduction sessions: For students in Scotland.

# Zoom courses being run by Mylyn McColl are proving very popular by those who have difficulty getting away or are unable to find accommodation near the Barn. Details of both inperson and online courses are shown below

As mentioned above we are delighted to announce that the BBV Introduction to Bookbinding sessions are to be held at Tedworth House once again and trialled at the Veterans' Outreach Support (VOS) in Portsmouth. In addition they will be available through Veterans Tribe Scotland (VTS) and Help for Heroes (H4H) Scotland with online sessions.

Online tutorials (via Zoom) for the Level 1 Foundation Bookbinding Course (Unit 118) are now well established in the BBV course programme. This course is normally a 5-day (Mon to Fri) course but for the on-line course it has been split into two modules, spread over two weeks.

In addition, C&G's Level 2 Courses (Units 220 and 221) are now available as Zoom on-line courses.

The online courses run from 10.00 to 16.00 each day but the tutor will be available until 16.30 to assist with questions and practice. A thirty-minute lunch break will be taken at approx 13.00. Details of these courses are given below.

 An optional assignment in the C&G Level 3 curriculum, this offers an
 alternative style of binding, where you will make a limp vellum cover,
 attached to a text-block with leather thongs.

- 10 May (Tue) (10.30-12.30) BBV Introduction to Bookbinding session at Tedworth House (TH). This short introductory session is intended for RRP Students at TH only.
- 16-20 May (Mon-Fri) C&G Level 1 Foundation Bookbinding Course (Unit 118) (Pamphlet Binding and Multi-section Binding) (At the Barn) This is for complete beginners and is the first unit in the Level 1 C&G's certificate in Bookbinding. You will gain a core knowledge of basic bookbinding skills and will make a single section pamphlet and multisection binding.
- 23-27 (Mon-Fri) C&G Level 1 Foundation Bookbinding Course (Unit 118) (Pamphlet Binding and Multi-section Binding) (At the Barn) This is for complete beginners and is the first unit in the Level 1 C&G's certificate in Bookbinding. You will gain a core knowledge of basic bookbinding skills and will make a single section pamphlet and multisection binding.
- 24-29 May (Tue-Sun) Level 3 Account-Style Binding (Spring back). An optional assignment in the C&G curriculum. The Account Book is a robust structure that was developed in the early nineteenth century for records which needed to open perfectly flat. It is sewn onto heavy webbing and has cloth-jointed endpapers. It is rounded, the edges decorated and the spine lined with calfskin. A laminated flange is inserted into the boards, along with the famous "spring back", a steam moulded spine which grips the book and throws the pages open. It is covered in reverse calf, goatskin and tooled with carbon.

#### **Advanced Box Ideas**

Box making has been really popular with students recently and these are a couple of examples of the type of boxes we've made. One is a fairly straight forward lift-off lid style box with a green book cloth base and decorative floral paper lid. The other is a slightly more complex structure bound in red bookcloth with angled sides, a hinged lid and magnetic closure. This also has internal walls in a contrasting yellow book cloth. Both were great fun to make and I loved the challenge of the red one - I really had to scratch my head to work out the structure and neat covering!
