BOOKBINDING AT HOME, CONTINUED...

BBV's First Online Bookbinding Course

Earlier this month BBV successfully ran its first Zoom webinar. The course was a **C&G Level 1 Foundation Bookbinding Course (Unit 118)**, a course for beginners in which students learnt how to create single section and multi-section books.

The instructor for this course was Mylyn McColl who has been bookbinding for some 15 years and although she has been teaching courses for several years, (including BBV courses at The Barn) she ventured into online training last year. BBV is now benefiting from her skills. She works from her studio at home and specialises in boxes, restoration and working with alternative materials.



Six students, Veterans and Band of Sisters from around the country, attended the online course and Mylyn took them through the steps to learn a number of different bookbinding techniques and skills to enable them to create a selection of handmade books. A pack of tools and materials had been sent to them via a courier in time for the course.

three in the second. All students found this arrangement good as it enabled them to fit in other domestic matters around the course.

Asked how the students found the pace of instruction on the course, they said: "Totally satisfactory, fine.", "The instructor paced it well and was able to recap various points throughout to those who needed further instruction without disrupting the course." "The pace of the course was well pitched." Asked if the course had a positive impact on their mood, the response was: "Yes." and "Hell yes!"

All students responded: "*Definitely yes*" to doing further bookbinding courses and to whether they were inspired to doing further bookbinding at home replied: "Yes, it has opened my eyes to new skills and knowledge" and "It could become very addictive."

All students said they had enjoyed the course.

BOOKBINDING COURSES - 2021 at Bound By Veterans

There remains a desire to get courses at The Barn up and running again as soon as possible but in the meantime courses are being planned online (via Zoom) and by the time you read this Newsletter the first such course will have been completed.

It is planned, in the first instant, to provide online tutorials (via Zoom) for the Level 1 Foundation Bookbinding Course (Unit 118). This course is normally a 5-day (Mon to Fri) course but for the on-line course it will be split into two modules, the first of two days and the second of three. Courses will run from 10.00 to 16.00 each day but the instructor will be available until 16.30 to assist with questions and practice. A thirty-minute lunch break will be taken each day at approx 13.00. Details of these courses are given below.
